

## Knight Hall Pollinator Garden Planting List

On the last page of this document, there is a map with a grid superimposed over it with coordinates, allowing easier location of plants within the Knight Hall Pollinator Garden.

Bloom dates indicate the earliest and latest dates we have observed plants blooming. Some years, they may not bloom this early or this late.

Notes: Not every plant in this garden is intended to be a good food source for pollinators. A few may be good habitat plants for pollinators or selected for their ornamental to make the garden more attractive and a few were existing plants. Some plants are too new to evaluate flower color, flowering period and height or we not have had a chance to record that information yet. We will periodically update this document in the future.
